

Registration and Fee Responsibility Agreement

By registering for classes for this semester, I acknowledge that I am entering into a legally binding educational contract with the University of Tennessee at Martin (UTM) to pay all tuition, room, board, parking citations, library fines, bookstore charges, class fees and other charges assessed by UTM ("Balance Owed") by the semester due dates. In the event that I do not pay the entire account balance in full by the semester due date, I understand and agree that I will not be able to schedule for future semesters or receive transcripts until my debt is paid in full.

I am responsible for fees associated with class drop/add if I fall below full-time status or completely withdraw from the University. In addition, if UTM is required to return Federal Title IV funds (federal aid) or federal veteran benefits as a result of my dropping of classes or withdrawal (official or unofficial), I acknowledge and agree that I am responsible for the repayment of the Federal Aid to the University.

If I leave the university with an outstanding debt, I understand and agree that my account may be assigned to UTM collection department due to non-payment and that in such event that I shall be responsible for and agree to pay, in addition to any balance owed, UTM internal collection fee which amounts to 15% of the balance owed. Further, I agree to pay and/or reimburse UTM any external collection fees of assessed by external collection agencies which may be based on a percentage of a maximum of 33.3% of the combined total of the balance owed plus the internal collection fee and further agree to pay all other costs of collection, fees, and expenses, including but not limited to reasonable attorney's fees and court costs incurred by UTM in any collection efforts along with interest as may be allowed by law.

I further acknowledge and agree that:

Any monies owed to UTM under a payment plan constitute an education loan that cannot be discharged in bankruptcy under 11 U.S.C. 523(a)(8).

If I am unable to attend UTM for any reason, I must officially withdraw through the Registrar's Office.
