**Scholarfest Goals:** Scholarfest is a festival of student research and creative presentations. Its purpose is to showcase the outstanding work UT Martin students are doing in the academic programs, to inspire other students' efforts by providing models of student achievement, and to afford students an experience of public presentation of their work.

**Who May Submit:** Undergraduate and graduate students from any academic discipline on campus are invited to participate. A faculty sponsor is required for each submission.

**Types of Presentations:** Any recognized product of research or creative activity may be submitted to Scholarfest. Presentations may include, but are not limited to:

- Essays submitted to the Interdisciplinary Student Writing Conference
- Senior research projects and other senior capstone achievements
- Other oral presentations of creative writing or research papers
- Poster presentations
- Art exhibits
- Music and drama performances
- Demonstrations (arts, humanities, sciences, technology, applied disciplines, etc.)
- Video presentations
- Team projects

**Submission:** The Scholarfest proposal form must be submitted together with an abstract describing the proposed presentation. The abstract should be sufficiently detailed to describe the main features of the presentation. It should be between one-half and one page in length, double-spaced, and word-processed. An electronic copy of the abstract of the abstract is preferred. Proposals will be accepted any time before the deadline of April 17, 2017.

**Selection:** The Scholarfest Committee will select participants from the nominated proposals. Selected participants will be notified by April 20, 2017, regarding date and time of presentation.
