

## 2026-2027 UTM DUAL ENROLLMENT APPLICATION

All students applying to the Dual Enrollment Program should have an electronic device, social security number, student email (personal email), parent email, parent phone number, and know which course they would like to enroll in for the semester.

- Go to [utm.edu/dualapply](http://utm.edu/dualapply) and click on the [UTM Dual Enrollment Application/Registration](#) link.
- Create a Dual Enroll Account**  
Complete all fields as required and select “Create Account.” Locate the temporary pin through text or email (whichever correspondence you selected you preferred) and enter the information as guided.

- Complete the UTM Dual Enrollment Application**
- Complete Parent Information**  
Once the parent’s information is entered into the application, they will receive a digital copy of the consent form (text or email) for them to sign. Your application will not process until this step is complete.
- Finalize Course Registration**  
Select your finalized course(s) you wish to take and select “**Register**” within each course. If you do not see the course(s) you are interested in, please contact the Dual Enrollment Office at 731-881-7853.
- Review the Application Status**  
Click on “Status” at the top of the page to ensure your application and course(s) are listed. Courses must be listed, the application will not be processed if they are not selected.

# 2026-2027 TN DUAL ENROLLMENT GRANT APPLICATION

All students interested in using the Tennessee Dual Enrollment Grant to assist with tuition payment must submit a Tennessee Dual Enrollment Grant Application. First time applicants must have a cumulative 3.0 unweighted high school GPA and returning applicants must have a cumulative 2.0 college GPA to remain eligible.

Login to the TSAC Student Portal (the red button in the top right corner)

First-time applicants must create an account. Returning users can login with their username and password previously used.
